

## How to find "The Point"

**GPS caution!!!!** Do follow **these instructions** after the "White Eagle".

(Many GPSs will take you across the beach to the original "Beach Gate" of The Point, which is OK if the tide is out....)

Cross Anglesey on the new **A55** road to **Junction 3**, the exit for **Valley** [this is the junction *after* the RAF Valley exit].

Follow the signs around two roundabouts to Valley and turn left at the first set of traffic lights - signed **B4545** for Treaddur Bay.

Over the level crossing (road swings right).

Over the bridge (not very obvious) in **Four Mile Bridge**; at the phone box and bus stop 150 yards after this bridge (a mile from the traffic lights) turn left, signed **Rhoscolyn**

After another mile and a bit pass the road on the left signed Silver Bay.

Take the next left, by the white house and before the road swings back right in front of the church.

Pass the **White Eagle**.

The road now bends right, passes the White Eagle back gate, turns sharp left, sharp right at a white house, and then sharp left. Don't go left this time!

Straight ahead is a steel gate between stone-built gateposts saying **THE POINT** on the left post.

This is the main entrance to The Point.

Follow this stone-surfaced drive and 500 yards on, just past a white house on the left, is a second galvanised gate (kept closed to keep stray cattle out).

Then there is a third [wooden] gate (to keep stray people out).

The Point is 200 yards further on, at the top of the rise.

[Up the slope 100 yards past the house is another gate - the track through this leads across the beach to rejoin the road from the White Eagle.]

Rhoscolyn is 4 miles south of Holyhead on Holy Island
